
From Coach to Chief: Climbing the Glass Ladder

Rhoda Mae Kerr was sworn in as the City of Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue Chief on July 2, 2018, becoming the City's first female Fire Chief in the 106-year history of the department.

A fourth-generation firefighter, Kerr began her career in the fire service in 1983 with the City of Fort Lauderdale. Over the next 20 years, she steadily rose through the ranks serving as a Firefighter, Driver/Engineer, Lieutenant, Battalion Chief, and Division Chief. She then went on to serve as Fire Chief of Little Rock Arkansas for 5 years and then spent almost 10 years as Fire Chief of the City of Austin, Texas, managing one of the nation's 20 largest fire departments.

In 2015, Chief Kerr was the first woman elected President of the International Association of Fire Chiefs in the 142-year history of the organization. She has served as President of the Metropolitan "Metro" Fire Chiefs Association and is a former President of the National Society of Executive Fire Officers.

In December 2016, Chief Kerr was appointed by President Barack Obama to the National Infrastructure Advisory Council, where she, along with academic, public, and private sector experts, advises the sitting President on matters regarding the security of critical infrastructure and related information systems.
